2018 Air Program Rulemakings

- 20 rescissions
- 42 amendments
- Effective dates from September 30, 2018, through March 30, 2019

Air Program RTR Actions—in general

- Updating incorporations by reference
- Removing obsolete, unnecessary or overly burdensome requirements, where possible
- Adding regulatory clarity
- Adding definitions specific to rules

Rule Changes and State Implementation Plan Impacts:

Rule changes:

- cannot interfere with any applicable requirement concerning attainment, reasonable further progress, or other CAA requirement --- CAA Section 110(I)
- must ensure equivalent or greater emissions reductions --- CAA Section 193

Three Significant Amendments:

1. Rewrite construction permit rule
2. Remove basic operating permits
3. Clarify open burning rule

1. Rewrite Construction Permit Rule, 10 CSR 10-6.060

- Clarify requirements
- Modernize vernacular and requirements
- Add option for “voluntary construction permit”
- Add option for a “general permit”

2. Remove Basic Operating Permits, 10 CSR 10-6.065

- Although Basic Operating Permits would no longer be required, underlying regulatory requirements still apply
- Other minor updates

3. Open Burning Rule, 10 CSR 10-6.045

- Clarify and simplify requirements
- Focus on critical requirements
- Remove the requirement for a written permit
