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

- Fertilizer License Exemption
- AgChem Facilities
- Commingled offsite open storage basin/vessel
 - Setbacks
 - Chain of Custody
 - Sampling

INMTS & LAMPs

- Land Application Rates
- Agronomic Rates Pollutant Removal
 - Soil Sampling
 - P-Index
 - University of Missouri Agricultural Extension
- Pollutant Limits



PFOA and PFOS

- Must sample all individual materials for PFOA and PFOS
 - Recommend source facilities conduct sampling
- Any detection of any PFAS compound requires soil sampling where land application of that material occurs
 - Minimum Detection Level = 4.0 ppt for this soil sampling
 - Method 1633



PFAS Soil Sampling Limits

	Mg/kg	µg/kg	ppt
PFOS	3.0 E-5	0.03	30
PFOA	6.1 E-5	0.061	61
All PFAS	9.1 E-5	0.091	91
